# Session

The Academic year of the school begins in April and ends in March.

#### Admission

The application for admission will be accepted only in the form prescribed by the School. No admission will be done until the students pass the test conducted by the school authorities. Only Registration of candidates does not guarantee admission as it depends upon availability of seats and selection procedure of the school. The age of child should be least 3 years at the time of admission in Nursery class. Parents/Guardians will have to produce Birth Certificates, S.L.C. Character Certificate and marks of previous exam of the child at the time of admission.

The medium of instruction is English through special emphasis is given on the teaching for Hindi as well. The medium of communication in the school premises is only English.

# Staff/Teacher

Every member of the teaching staff is highly qualified and well experienced.

# Discipline

The School will enforce strict discipline among the students with the help and co-operation of parents/guardians. The student will remain in the school for 5.5 hrs. and with their parents for the remaining period of the day and so the role of the parents is very important.

The Parents are requested to give sufficient time to their wards at home and watch even their minor activities and affectionately suggest the right way of doing things. In fact parents are the real teachers. It does not mean that we are shifting our responsibility. To build up the character of students and to make them utmost disciplined is our prime responsibility. Actually, to expel the students on the ground of indiscipline is to accept our failure. Doon Public School teaches all possible steps to bring such students on right path with the parent's co-operation. In our opinion expulsion from school or severe punishments are negative attitudes. To make the students disciplined is our prime responsibility and we accept it.

#### Promotion

Promotion is granted on the basis of whole year performance of the pupil and regularity in attendance.

Note: All cases of doubt regarding promotion are left entirely to the discretion of the principal. Parents must not come for reconsideration once the decision has been given. Group discussion with the principal, vice principal or teacher is not allowed for the same.

# House System

In order to create healthy sense of competition among the students, all students of the school are divided among four houses, which is as follows:

# Gandhi House, Jawahar House, Shubhas House and Ramanujan House.

Each house will be under the control of a teacher, who is called the House Master. All students of each house will be headed by a senior student known as House Captain, who reports to the House Master. The House Captain and House Master will be responsible for the performance of their Houses in all the activities of the school like games, sports, debates, dance & drama etc. Each house will be responsible for conducting the school prayer term wise for one week.

#### Science & Maths Lab

The School provides adequate facilities for holding science practical classes. We are having Physics, Chemistry, Biology & Maths Lab in our school. All laboratories are quite spacious and fully equipped with adequate scientific equipments, chemicals and other teaching appliances.

# Withdrawals

Before withdrawing a student from the school, an application must be submitted to the Principal before one month. Those who leave in the month of May must in all cases pay fees for the month of June being vacation period. Transfer Certificate is not issued until all dues of the school are cleared.

Note:- i) <u>Caution Money is returned only if the student leaves the school after completing the session.</u>

ii) Transfer Certificate will be issued only for Current Academic Session.

# Absence

Students absenting on the previous day are not admitted to the class without the permission of the Class Teacher. Leave is granted on medical grounds. Repeated absence with or without leave for more than 2 weeks renders the students liable to have his name struck off the roll. Re-admission may be granted only after permission of Principal/Director. On re-admission, a re-admission fee of Rs. 500/- will be charged. Rs. 5/-per day will charged as a absence fine.

# Mode of Examination

For all classes there will be Term-1 and Term-2 Examinations. Besides these examinations, Two Pre-Term Tests, weekly tests and monthly tests will also be held. Progress of the students will be assessed on the basis of above tests.

Note:-A student absent in any examination for any reason will not be re-examined.

- Some relaxation in cut off marks will be given to sports person who have played at state/national level.
- Students must attend class regularly and it is mandatory to complete 80% of regular attendance in class, failing which the students will not be promoted or allowed to appear in the Board Examination as per CBSE norms.

# ABOUT HOSTEL

#### Facilities in the Hostel

- Magnificent building with proper ventilation, sufficient water and hygienic sanitary arrangements.
- Round the clock supervision by Hostel Superintendent and Warden.
- Regular Health Check-up by specialists and medical facility.

#### Food

The School provides nourishing and wholesome vegetarian and non-vegetarian food. Milk, fruits, curd, sweet dishes, chicken, mutton and eggs are part of regular diet. Breakfast, lunch, refreshment and dinner are served strictly on time.

The menu is prepared by a committee consisting of the Director, Principal, Hostel Superintendent and Wardens. Every care is taken so that the Boarders should get balanced and nutritious diet required for their physical and mental development. Non-vegetarian food is served to the Boarders at least three days in a week. Special vegetarian dishes are served to the vegetarian Boarders on these days.

#### Health

No student having any type of contagious or infectious disease is allowed to join the Hostel. He has to produce a Medical Certificate at the time of joining the Hostel if he had been suffering from any such disease. Regular health check of the Boarders is done under program of the school. Students who are under any prolonged line of treatment must bring with them a detailed treatment history and prescriptions by the treating doctor for enabling the school doctor to take charge of the same, more specifically. No medicines or tonics should be handed over to the students

directly. All medicines, medical certificate, reports and prescriptions should be handed over to the Warden/Hostel Superintendent.

### Extra Tuition

Besides Hostel coaching extra tuition may be given to the boarders in subject in which they are found weak. For the sake of continuity, students must be coached at home during summer and wintervacations.

# Pocket Money

The Parent are requested to allow their ward only as much pocket money as recommended by the school. To teach the value of money to the students is also a part of our responsibility.

# Correspondence

To sustain and promote their emotional well being the school encourages students to communicate their parents once every fortnight, preferably on Sunday. Parents are also requested to correspond with their wards regularly. The school itself will inform the parents if there is anything adverse regarding health and behavior of their wards. All letters should be addressed to the Director/Principal only and not by name or not any member or staff.

# Valuables

It is the one of the objectives of the school to keep the students away from luxurious life during their formative period. 'Simple Living — High Thinking' is our motto especially during student life. Keeping the above mentioned objective in view, students are strictly prohibited to bring in or keep with them valuable items like cash, VCRs, TVs, Tape Recorders, Mobile and Gold Jewellery etc.

# • Fee Regulations

Hostel Fee is payable on quarterly basis in advance. However monthly payment of hostel fee may be allowed under the special consideration of the Director. Bills for additional consumable etc. are debited to the Boarder's a/c during his stay in school and a statement of the dues will be issued towards the end of September and February and is to be honored within 15 days of its receipt. Fees are payable for the entire year irrespective of the fact that a student is in the Hostel for a part of the session.

- No boarder will be allowed to go home and return to Hostel after the vacation unless the a/c for the previous school term has been settled in full.
- Caution Money of Hostel is not returned if the student leaves the Hostel without completing the session.
- No reduction is allowed for broken periods. All dues are to be cleared before the student leaves the school.
- Fee must be deposited on or before 10<sup>th</sup> of every month. Failure may lead to a fine of Rs. 200/-. If the hostel fee is not deposited for two consecutive months, the student may be sent back to the parent and his admission from the hostel will be cancelled.

# Withdrawals (from Hostel)

1) Three months advance notice in writing is required, if a parent wishes not to continue his ward in Hostel during the session.

Note: In case of immediate withdrawal, parent will have to pay 3 months fee of Hostel in lieu of non-notice period.

2) Three month's advance notice in writing shall be required if a parent wishes not to send his ward for the following session. Ordinarily, such notice should reach the school not later than 31<sup>st</sup> December of the year preceding that in which the ward is sought to be withdrawn.

Failing receipt of such notice or receipt thereof at a later date, it will be deemed that the parents have given consent for the enrolment of their

ward for the next year and accommodation will be reserved for him accordingly and no one else will be allocated that accommodation under any circumstances.

 No withdrawals are ordinally permitted during mid-session except in special circumstance. No refund will be allowed as perfee regulation.

# Important

Clothes and all other belongings should be marked with the code number given by the Hostel Superintendent. No item will be accepted without the marking. The name of the Boarder will be written with white enamel paint on his black painted steel trunk.

Parents are requested to inspect every items of their ward's kit before he joints the Hostel. The parents are liable to over look the fact that their ward is growing and he may have out grown his clothes. His shoes may be worn out and need replacement.

# General Rules & Regulations

- The parents who want Hostel facility for their wards must mention it in the Registration Form.
- The parents are required to supply to their wards all the materials required by the school to the use of their wards. (Refer to the detailed list given)
- The Boarders are allowed to meet those relatives only whose names are mentioned in the visitor's list of the Boarder by his parents.
- When permitted to go out, the Boarders must be accompanied by their parents or by some duly authorized person. On their return, they must report to their Warden/Hostel Superintendent.
- No Boarder is allowed to meet any body during study hours. Urgent cases will be considered by the Hostel Superintendent.
