स्कूल लाइब्रेरी जहाँ छात्र और छात्राएँ अपनी पसंद की पुस्तकें पढ़ते हैं। यह ज्ञान का प्रकाश स्तंभ है। स्कूल लाइब्रेरी सार्वजनिक लाइब्रेरी से अलग होती है। ये शिक्षार्थी-उन्मुख प्रयोगशालाओं के रूप में काम करती हैं। ये स्कूल के पाठ्यक्रम का समर्थन और विस्तार करती हैं। एक स्कूल लाइब्रेरी स्कूल में उपयोग की जानेवाली

सभी सामग्री के लिए केन्द्र और समन्वय एजेंसी के रूप में कार्य करती है।

शोधकर्ताओं ने 19 अमेरिकी राज्यों और एक कनाडाई प्रांत में किए गए 60 से अधिक अध्ययनों से प्रदर्शित किया गया है कि स्कूल पुस्तकालयों का छात्रों की उपलब्धि पर सकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़ता है। इसके अलावा ओहियो में किए गए एक अध्ययन से पता चला है कि सर्वेक्षण किए

गए 99.4 प्रतिशत छात्रों का मानना था कि उनके स्कूल लाइब्रेरियन और स्कूल लाइब्रेरी मीडिया कार्यक्रमों ने उन्हें स्कूल में सफल होने में मदद की है।

21वीं सदी में स्कूल लाइब्रेरी मीडिया सेंटर छात्रों की बढ़ती उपलब्धि और सकारात्मक केन्द्रित स्कूल सुधार के केन्द्र हो सकते हैं और होने भी चाहिए।

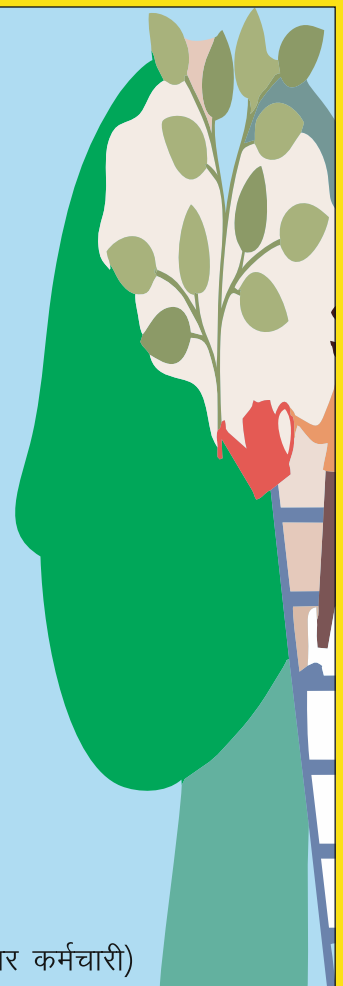

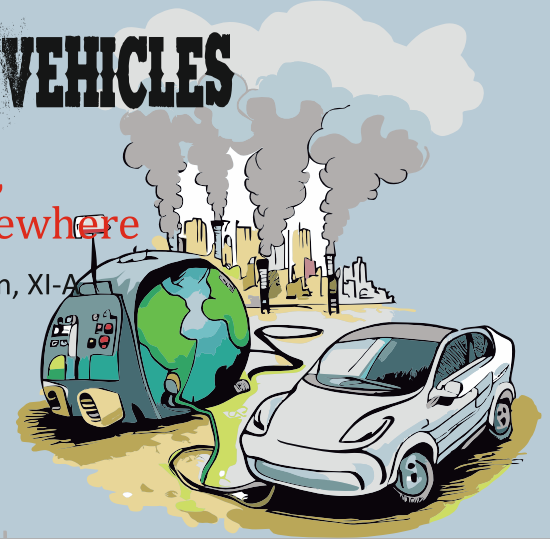
POLLUTION CAUSED BY ELECTRIC VEHICLES

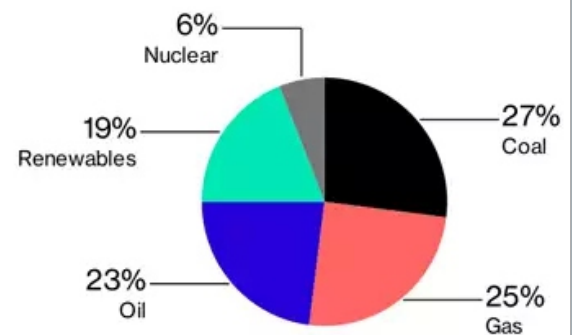

Nowadays people think that Electric Vehicles are sustainable way of transport because they do not produce any carbon emission. That's true but the reality is quite different. To understand how Electric Vehicles create pollution first we have to know how they are powered. They generally use lithium ion battery to run and lithium is a very rare mineral.
